## 6. Student Peer Supporters

To better support our students' social and emotional well-being, we will be starting a pilot programme to train selected Sec 1 - 3 students as Peer supporters in Term 3. This is a programme where student peer supporters will be trained to:

- observe and identify signs of distress in peers
- listen actively to peers' words or feelings
- refer peers to teachers and counsellors in a sensitive manner

Student peer supporters will be mentored and supported by a team of teachers. We will provide more details to the parents of students selected as peer supporters in a separate letter.

## 7. Youth Day, Racial Harmony Day, National Day Celebrations, Teachers' Day Celebration

We celebrate Youth Day this year on **Monday 3 July**. Please note that this is a school holiday. Racial Harmony Day will be commemorated on 21 July, in conjunction with Hari Raya celebrations. Students and staff are encouraged to dress in ethnic costumes on this day to celebrate the diversity of cultures in Singapore.

The school will be celebrating National Day on **Tuesday 8 August**. The programme will include a parade segment to start off the celebrations, followed by a mini carnival helmed by our CCA groups where students will get the chance to play traditional games at the various CCA stalls. The carnival will be followed by a school concert. Students will be dismissed by 10.30 am on 8 August. Please note that 10 August is a school holiday.
